I am pleased to inform that Uproot was invited by Arab Gulf Programme for Development (**AGFUND**), to compete for 2018 AGFUND challenge, to end poverty in all its forms by year 2030. This complex proposal on Pakistan was submitted on November 24, 2018 with following objectives:



Promote Education:

- 1) Train 60,000 teachers
- 2) Rehabilitation of 1,800 school

Women Empowerment:

Train 9,600 women

Assistance Program:

- 1) Medical:
 - a) Minor surgery treatment of 120,000 patients
 - **b)** Intermediate surgery treatment of 60,000 patients
 - c) Lifesaving surgery treatment of 60,000 patients
